Trade wine for gin cocktails in downtown Napa

ZuZu, an intimate Spanish tapas bar that opened 20 years ago, expanded into the space next door on Napa's Main Street for a trendy new gin bar. Featuring quirky art and Mediterranean design elements — rough-hewn wooden tables, terracotta tile floors and ironwork — it's officially Napa's new go-to late-night option. Choose from more than 15 gins sourced from across the globe, including Ireland, New Zealand and Mexico, and several tonics to build your own G&T. The bar also serves a small menu of snacks and ZuZu's signature paella.
